IMPORTANT NOTES TO EXHIBITORS

CERTIFICATION: A certification in accordance with Chapter 3, Section 2 of the AKC Tracking Regulations must be submitted with the entry form for a dog that has not passed a TD or TDU.

TEST LIMIT & RANDOM DRAW: If entries received exceed the test limit of 4 dogs, a public drawing will be held Wednesday, March 21, 2019, at 3:00 p.m. at Panera bread at 144th and I-25 in the Orchard. Preference for the first track drawn will be given to DFTA test workers who submit a DFTA issued worker certification with their entry form. Visit the DFTA website for details of the test worker preference process. An attempt to notify entrants will be made by the secretary within 48 hours of the draw. Long distance phone calls from exhibitors to the Trial Secretary will be returned collect.

ENTRY FEE; \$65.00. (This includes the 50 cent AKC recording fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee.) The entry fee for Junior Handlers is Zero. A junior must have an AKC Junior Handler number and be less than 18 years of age on the day of the event.

Entries sent by **OVERNIGHT DELIVERY** must be marked "no signature required." Entry fee checks for alternates who do not participate will be shredded by the secretary.

ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, except as required by the AKC regulations in Chapter 1, Section 15 and 17. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judges or barred from competition by the test committee, entry fees will not be refunded. If, because of storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry fees will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE. The owner of a bitch in season MUST notify the Test Secretary prior to drawing for tracks that their bitch is in season. Such bitch(es) will run only after all other dogs have run.

USE THE OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ENTRY FORM and write "Tracking" in the "Obedience Trial Class" space. Telegraphed, telephoned, unsigned, conditional or incomplete entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all of the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Denver Foothills Tracking Association assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person, theft of personal property, theft, injury, or death of any animal or loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site, or in transit to or from the site.

NOTICES REGARDING OUR TEST SITE: Exhibitors may not practice at the test site within three days of the test. Exhibitors and spectators are not permitted to park along the park roads. This is a park rule! Designated drivers will take exhibitors and spectators to track drop-off points or viewing points. Dogs owned or under the control of any persons associated with the Tracking Test must be ON LEAD at all times. This is an AKC rule as well as a Park rule!

Training at Chatfield requires a Park issued permit that restricts training to specific fields. DFTA holds a training permit for its members and people training for DFTA tests. Visit the DFTA website for details of the restrictions.

A \$9.00 Park Entry Fee, separate from the Test Entry Fee, is required to enter Chatfield State Park. The exhibitor is responsible for paying this fee. Chatfield State Park is a heavily used, public park, located along the foothills of the mountains. Exhibitors can expect to encounter horses, bicycles and people on established paths through the tracking fields. Wildlife such as deer, elk, coyotes and rattlesnakes are known to reside in the park.

Some of the test tracks may not be easily accessible from the road; exhibitors may need to walk to and/from the track.

Directions from Titan Road: Go from Santa Fe to Titan Rd; proceed west on Titan Road for 1.8 miles to Roxborough Park Rd. Turn right (north) on Roxborough Park Rd. and proceed 1.5 miles to the Entrance Gate. After paying the fee, proceed to Heronry Parking Lot (on the right side) for 1.1 miles. Park in parking lot

Directions from Wadsworth Blvd: Proceed south on Wadsworth to Waterton Rd. Turn left and proceed for 4.3 miles to the light at Rampart Range Rd. Turn left (north) on Rampart Range Rd which will become Titan Rd. Turn left (north) on Roxborough Park Rd. and proceed 1.5 miles to the Entrance Gate. After paying the fee, proceed to Heronry Parking Lot (on the right side) for 1.1 miles. Park in parking lot

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
