

THE ORDER OF RUNNING will be determined by a draw for tracks at the time called for on the face of this premium list.

SPECIAL NOTE: Any exhibitor whose dog passes a Tracking Test AFTER the closing dates for the CSPC Test but BEFORE the running of the test may withdraw their entry and receive a full refund of the entry fee PROVIDED that such a withdrawal is made by phone, in writing or in person to the Test Secretary prior to the test and further provided that alternate exhibitors are available and willing to take the spot of the exhibitor withdrawing the entry.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Columbine State Poodle Club assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person, theft of personal property, theft, injury or death of any animal or loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site, or in transit to or from the site.

IMPORTANT NOTICES REGARDING OUR TEST SITE: Exhibitors may not practice at the test site within three days of the test. Exhibitors & spectators are not permitted to park along the park roads. This is a park rule! Exhibitor driver supplied by the exhibitor will drop off and pick up the exhibitor. Spectators may park in a designated parking lot and walk to viewing areas when feasible. There is a park entrance fee of **\$10 per vehicle** or current Colorado state parks sticker.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE HEADQUARTERS: From I-25, take Hwy C470 west to Wadsworth exit. Go south to second stoplight, turn left into the main park entrance. After going through the entry booth (there is a fee to enter the park), turn right on the main park road; take the next right (at livery sign), staying on the right when the road forks, continue to parking lot HQ.

An award will be given to each handler and dog team that passes the TD or TDX test provided by the Columbine State Poodle Club.

IMPORTANT NOTES TO EXHIBITORS

CERTIFICATION: For a dog that has not passed an AKC Tracking Dog or Tracking Dog Urban test, entry must include an original statement dated within two years and signed by a person who has been approved by the American Kennel Club to judge tracking tests or by a person/evaluator who has handled a dog to a TDX or VST title within the last 10 years, certifying that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test.

TEST LIMIT & RANDOM DRAW: This test is limited to 3 TD and 3 TDX dogs. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks will be exchanged on a basis of 2 TDs for 1 TDX. Entries will remain open until 5:00 pm, Thursday, Feb. 18, 2021. If entries received exceed the test limits, a public drawing will be held at 5:30pm, Thursday, Feb. 18, 2020 at **Caribou Coffee**, 1400 E Hampden Ave, Englewood, CO 80113. Any interested parties may attend. Acknowledgments will be emailed to all entrants as soon as practicable. If alternate entries remain after the draw, an additional draw will be conducted to determine the order in which the alternates will run. In all cases, preference will be given to POODLES first, followed by all other breeds / AKC Canine Partners.

ENTRY FEE: \$65.00 (TD) and \$125.00 (TDX). The entry fee includes the \$3.00 AKC event service fee and the 50 cent AKC recording fee. Make checks payable to Columbine State Poodle Club and send entry form, **signed COVID waiver** and **Certification** documentation as outlined above to: Tracey Griffith, 5976 S Elizabeth Way, Centennial, CO 80121-2814.

ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date (except as noted in the "Special Note: on page 4 of this premium list), nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judges or barred from competition by the test committee. If, because of storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry fee will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE. The owner of a bitch in season MUST notify the Test Secretary prior to drawing for tracks that their bitch is in season. Such bitches will run only after all the other dogs have run and must be kept away from the immediate vicinity of the test prior to running. **USE THE OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ENTRY FORM** and write "TD" or "TDX" in the "Obedience Trial Class" space. Emailed, telegraphed, telephone, unsigned, conditional or incomplete entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us). **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. 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INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

CSPC – COVID-19 Rules – PLEASE READ

At this point in time (Orange Alert – High Risk), we plan to hold our February Combined TD/TDX tracking test. If the event must be canceled, CSPC will notify exhibitors and entry checks will be shredded.

If the event has not been officially cancelled, but an exhibitor or a member of their household has been diagnosed with COVID-19, we will, upon submission of a medical note, refund entry fees for that exhibitor.

Please understand that neither Columbine State Poodle Club nor Chatfield State Park can completely guarantee your safety and good health. CSPC will work to adhere to all current Government and facility regulations regarding COVID. We are making lots of adjustments to try to make it as safe as possible, but it will be up to each exhibitor to decide if this trial is right for you, or if it would be better for you to pass. If you are unable to follow all procedures, we will ask you to leave and your entry fees will not be refunded. If you refuse to leave, we will have a Trial Committee meeting. We want everyone to be safe and we need your help and cooperation to make this as safe as possible for everyone. Everyone attending is required to sign the COVID waiver and abide by all trial rules.

Masks: The proper wearing of masks (securely covering nose and mouth) WILL be required at all times except when handling a dog on a track. Please bring your own mask.

Social Distancing: Please remember to adhere to 6 - foot social distancing at all times. This includes around the judges, tracklayers & workers.

Handwashing: The club will have hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes. The club will provide disposable gloves for workers, if needed. We will periodically sanitize commonly touched areas, but please don't rely on this. Remember to WASH YOUR HANDS frequently.

At Headquarters – Chatfield Horse Corral

We ask everyone to remain close to their vehicle until the briefing and draw. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.

Avoid touching other dogs that are not your responsibility.

Wear a mask and maintain social distancing at all times. (Masks are optional for exhibitors during the tracking.)

Drivers

In order to limit the number of people in a closed vehicle and possible contamination of the interior vehicle space, exhibitors should provide their own driver to drop off at the start and pick up at the end of the track in the exhibitors' own vehicle. If no driver available, exhibitors should plan to walk back to the start of the track to get their vehicle. There will not be a spectator driver. Check with club for nearest parking lot and please bring cell phone for communications.

Per Parks Office, all placarded vehicles must follow these guidelines:

No more than two vehicles may park in the same general location at any time.

Roadside parking is not permitted within 100 yards of a designated parking area.

Placard must be displayed in the driver's side vehicle windshield and visible for inspection.

Absolutely no parking in "No Parking" zones.

Roadside parking is only permitted on gravel or hard surfaces after rain or snow.

Roadside parking must not impede normal traffic, restrict roadway visibility, or create a bottleneck.

Scent Articles

While laying the track, the track layer will touch articles to leave a scent for the tracking dog. It is advised that the exhibitor wear gloves when taking the found articles from the dog. Make sure the found articles get acknowledged by the judges as the dog finds them. Exhibitor has the option to keep the articles or drop them on the track to reduce possible transmission of infection between track layer and exhibitor. Exhibitors are encouraged to wash their hands or use sanitizer as soon as possible.

Entourage

Judges and volunteers will wear masks if closer than 6 feet while observing the dog and handler. Check for rules for spectators on the track.

Food & Water

Consistent with these guidelines we cannot provide any snacks or potluck food service but bottled water will be available. Exhibitors may bring their own snacks or lunch.

If conditions change, there may be additional requirements that we have not yet considered, so please keep an eye on your email for any updates on safe practice procedures for this event.
