

THE ORDER OF RUNNING will be determined by a draw for tracks at the time called for on the face of this premium list.

SPECIAL NOTE Any exhibitor whose dog passes a Tracking Test **AFTER** the closing date for the TBHC Test but **BEFORE** the running of the test may withdraw their entry and receive a full refund of the entry fee **PROVIDED** that such withdrawal is made by phone, in writing or in person to the Test Secretary prior to the test and further provided that alternate exhibitors are available and willing to take the spot of the exhibitor withdrawing the entry.

RISK The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by all the Rules and Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The Timberline Basset Hound Club assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person, theft of personal property, theft, injury or death of any animal or loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site, or in transit to or from the site.

IMPORTANT NOTICES REGARDING OUR TEST SITE:

Exhibitors are requested to not practice at the test site within three days of the test without first contacting the test chair to find out which areas may be used. Exhibitors and spectators are not permitted to park along the park roads. This is a park rule! Designated drivers will take exhibitors and spectators to drop-off or viewing areas.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE HEADQUARTERS:

From I25, take Hwy C470 west to Wadsworth exit. Go south to second stoplight, turn left into main park entrance. After going through the entry booth (there is a fee to enter the park), turn right on the main park road, take next right (at livery sign), staying on the right when the road forks, continue to parking lot.

IMPORTANT NOTES TO EXHIBITORS

CERTIFICATION With the entry form for a dog that has not passed an AKC Tracking Dog Test, there must be filed an original statement dated within two (2) years and signed either a person approved to judge tracking tests, or by a person/evaluator who has handled a dog to a TDX or VST title within the last 10 years.

TEST LIMIT AND RANDOM DRAW: This test is limited to 4 TD's and 2 TDX dogs. Entries will remain open until 5:00 p.m. Wednesday, February 22, 2023. If entries received exceed the test limit, a public drawing will be held at 7:00 p.m. Wednesday, February 22, 2023. at Carol Makowski's home, 9007 Tahoe Lane, Boulder, CO 80301. Any interested parties may attend. Acknowledgement will be mailed to all entrants as soon as practicable. If alternate entries remain after the draw, an additional draw will be conducted to determine the order in which alternates will run. In all cases, preference will be given to BASSET HOUNDS first, followed by all other breeds.

ENTRY FEE: \$65.00 (TD) and \$130.00 (TDX). The entry fee includes the \$3.00 AKC event service fee and the 50 cent AKC recording fee. Make checks payable to Timberline Basset Hound Club and send with **entry form and certification documents to Carol Makowski, 9007 Tahoe Lane, Boulder, CO 80301**

ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date (except as noted in the "Special Note" on page 4 of this premium list), nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or barred from competition by the test committee. If, because of storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry will be made.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE. The owner of a bitch in season **MUST** notify the Test Secretary prior to drawing for tracks that their bitch is in season. Such bitch(es) will run only after all the other dogs have run and must be kept away from the immediate vicinity of the test prior to running.

USE THE OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ENTRY FORM and write "TD" or "TDX" in the "Obedience Class" space. Telegraphed, telephoned, unsigned, conditional or incomplete entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of forms without the Agreement and Instructions on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.
